Europeans staying outside Ontario will be accompanied by CERE chaperone to the gates and/ or on domestic flights to their final destination (for groups of 10 persons and more)

### Phase 2: Canadians stay in Europe between February 2<sup>nd</sup> and April 16<sup>th</sup>

**Day 2:**  
Visit of Paris (2 nights in Paris)

**Day 3:**  
Meeting host family, transfer by the Europeans partner's families

**Return on April 16<sup>th</sup> to Canada**

**Included** in the program, **April International insurance:** repatriations, hospitalization and civil liability.

**CERE:** supervisors chaperone the students Canadians on transatlantic flights.
